The following procedure will be used for all national tests.

At least 2 people will always be present to oversee the following for national tests, unless otherwise stated in Government documentation:

Before Tests

- Nationally published guidance will be followed at all times.
- Test papers arrive, boxes are opened and contents checked against delivery note – papers, envelopes etc. by two people and signed where appropriate.
- Teachers’ guides are distributed where applicable.
- Any discrepancies are reported to the appropriate bodies immediately.
- The papers will be stored, in date order, in a locked cabinet in the school office.
- Teacher packs, where provided, will be locked separately to limit errors in opening packs.
- All parents and pupils, where appropriate, will be informed of the test timetable and any special arrangements (e.g. seating, readers).

During Tests

- Nationally published guidance will be followed at all times.
- Each time cabinets storing tests are opened, this will be recorded and witnessed.

After Each Test

- Nationally published guidance will be followed at all times.
- Completed scripts will be gathered in according to list order and returned to the school office.
- This order will be checked and the scripts immediately packed and stored in a locked cabinet until collection or marking.
- After the test window closes, teacher packs may be opened.

Governors will be encouraged to visit school to check procedures throughout this period.
