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"Children are at the centre of all we do"

Dear parents/carers,

Year 6 pupils have been enjoying the opportunity to spend time in school prior to their move to secondary school in September. We have been delighted to welcome them back to enjoy their time together and complete transition tasks set by secondary schools.

School Governors have been monitoring pupil numbers in school so that we are able to ensure we are socially distancing and keeping group sizes within permitted limits. Guidance (below) states that we should prioritise key worker pupils and then children in Reception and Year 1:

Schools should focus first on continuing to provide places for priority groups of all year groups (children of critical workers and vulnerable children). Then, to support children's early learning, you should prioritise groups of children as follows:

primary schools - nursery (where applicable), reception and year 1

Schools should not plan on the basis of a rota system, either daily or weekly, as they do not provide the consistency of education and care required for the youngest children, who also require more support with remote education. DfE guidance, June 2020.

Due to the rise in key worker working hours, the childcare facility is becoming very full. Governors have therefore had to take the decision to close the Year 6 education facility to use this space and staffing for pupils of key workers. The last day for Year 6 pupils will therefore be Friday 26th June.

Should you be a key worker and need childcare beyond this date, please book a childcare place for your Year 6 child at booking@heslerton.n-yorks.sch.uk You will need to give details of your dates at work please. Childcare places will only be provided for your child on days when key workers are at work and where no adult is present at home to safely look after them. Confirmation of your child's place will be issued.

Should your child be eligible for free transport to school, please book transport for the days you have childcare confirmed for at https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/schools-and-childrens-services-during-coronavirus-covid-19#transport
