What does a Child and Family Support Worker Do?

Provide a listening ear and support to families.

Work as link between home and school, keeping lines of communication open between parents and school staff.

Provide opportunities for parents to meet with other parents through Parent Cafes/courses.

Refer and signpost families to support programs which provide parents with opportunities to share ideas and experiences.

Work with children in the school who need extra support.

Signpost parents and families to services within the area, depending on their need.

Help families by assisting them with the Early Help/Team Around the Family process.

Work with other professionals to help families achieve their goals.

Who Can Contact the Child and Family Support Worker?



The answer to that question is **any parent/carer** who has a child at West Kidlington Primary School.

Parents/carers do not need to be referred. Any parent can contact my- self (Family Support Advisor) via the contact details provided or by asking a member of staff.

We encourage all parents/carers to get in touch, especially to let the school know about anything important that is happening in the home which may affect the children's learning.

What can the Child and Family Support Worker Help With?

- Changes in the family situation (i.e. bereavement or parent separation)
- Behavior management
- Advice around issues that may have an impact on the family home (i.e. illness, domestic violence, disability, financial difficulties).
