

These symbols may help Parent’s Carer’s to support their children with symbols relating to Online Safety.






We have assembled these symbols with the support of Kidsmart. Please remember that we are always here to offer help and advice to support you with your child and help to try and keep them safe.














Emails:

Emails or attachments may contain viruses.























Emails or attachments may contain unpleasant photos.







Meeting People:






 You may  meet people  online  in  chat areas.






You may   make friends  online.

People   can  tell lies about  their  age and  gender.






Tell  an  adult  if you are  thinking of  meeting someone.
