	Exactly 100%	Fantastic attendance which will enable your child to reach their true potential. They will be rewarded for this at a final assembly if it stays at 100%
	95-99.99%	Very good attendance which is above the government target of 97%. This will support your child and give them a very good chance of achieving their true potential. This will be praised in school.
	93-94.9%	Attendance is slightly below our target level which may mean that your child is at risk of not achieving their true potential.
	90-92.9%	Attendance is below average and your child's education will be suffering. It is important to know that while 90% attendance sounds high, it actually equals ½ a day EVERY WEEK missed from school. At this stage, you may be invited to meet with school staff who will work with you to support and improve attendance.
	85.1%-89.9%	Attendance is well below average and your child will now fall into the category of persistent absentee. Your child will not be achieving their targets and will be below age-related expectations. At this stage, you may be invited to meet with the Local Authority's Attendance Officer. You may be liable for prosecution if no improvement is made.
	Below 85%	Your child's attendance level is so serious that they will be failing in school and, as a result, the Local Authority Attendance Officer will become involved and will be monitored. If there is not an immediate and significant improvement, the Local Authority must consider prosecution
