October	Courage/ Determination	Noun 1 the ability to do something that frightens one. 2 Strength in the face of pain or grief.
November	Friendship	Noun 1 a person with whom one has a bond of mutual affection, typically one exclusive of sexual or family relations. 2 A familiar or helpful thing. 3 A person who supports a particular cause or organisation.
December	Honesty	Noun 1 the quality of being honest. 2 A plant with purple or white flowers and round, flat, translucent seed pods, so named from its seed pods, translucency symbolizing lack of deceit.
January	Humility	Noun a humble view of one's own importance.
February	Patience	Noun 1 the capacity to tolerate delay, trouble, or suffering without becoming angry or upset.
March	Quality	Noun (pl. qualities) 1 the degree of excellence of something as measured against other similar things. 2 general excellence. 3 a distinctive attribute or characteristic.
April	Responsibility/ Self-belief	Noun (pl. responsibilities) 1 the state or fact of being responsible. 2 the opportunity or ability to act independently and take decisions required to do as part of a job, role, or legal obligation.
May	Thoughtfulness	Adjective 1 absorbed in or involving thought. 2 showing careful consideration or attention. 3 showing regard for other people.
June	Trust	Noun 1 firm belief in the reliability, truth, ability, or strength of someone or something. 2 acceptance of truth or a statement without evidence or investigation. 3 the state of being responsible for someone or something.
July	Unity/ Teamwork	Noun (pl. unities) 1 the state of being united or forming a whole. 2 a thing forming a complex whole. 3 in mathematics the number one.
