

Dear Parent and Carers.

- **Covid-19 Reporting** you must email the school office immediately if your child, or someone in your household develops Covid-19 symptoms or receives a positive test result.

I understand that it is frustrating for some of you, but we need to keep some restrictions in place to try to protect us from Covid. This week some people have been going against the flow and closely passing people coming in the gates this is not safe practice, so please follow the required route.
