EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

Role play - home corner, baby clinic and dressing up boxes
Painting - plate faces, hand prints, ourselves, families
Making funny face biscuits
Cutting and sticking - bodies, shape pictures
Junk modelling
