

Half Term Curricular Overview

Year 4 Autumn 1



ENGLISH Reading

The children will identify key words and phrases in a text.

They will also give their own opinion of a text and build on other children's ideas.

Writing

We will be studying persuasive arguments, diary entries and descriptive settings.

Speaking and Listening

I can justify an answer by giving evidence.

I show that I understand the main point and the details in a discussion.

I adapt what I am saying to the needs of the listener or audience (increasingly).



SCIENCE

Our Science this half term will be Living things and their habitats.

The children will recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways. They will explore classification keys and recognise that environments can change and pose danger to living things. They will also look at food chains and habitats.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Real PE - In PE we will be considering cognitive elements of playing a sport. We will use coordination to learn ball skills and play ball games.

We will also look at dynamic balance—balancing on a line.

We will also be undertaking a course of swimming lessons.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Through studying different religions we will consider "How we should live our lives?".

HUMANITIES

History

This term we have a history focus. We will be exploring life in Ancient Greece and asking Why are the Greeks heroes? The children will learn all about foods, clothing, shops, transport and daily life and what influence the Greeks had on architecture and other parts of life today. We start with a small geography unit asking "is Europe the same all over?". We will locate Greece and features of the landscape today.

COMPUTING/SAFE COMPUTING

The children will use Scratch to create quizzes and ask questions. using programming language.

Throughout the half term we will look at e-safety issues that link to being safe online, considering what personal information should ever be shared etc

ART

Children will use water colours to create images of landscapes.

MATHS

In Maths we will begin
by reviewing and
consolidating our
knowledge of place
value. Moving on to
develop our methods for
addition, subtraction,
money, multiplication
and division. Finally
reviewing position and
direction and developing
our knowledge of
fractions
