



The 'PREVENT' Strategy










Prevent is one of the four elements of CONTEST, the government's counter terrorism strategy. It aims to stop people becoming terrorists or supporting terrorism.

The PREVENT Strategy -

- Responds to the ideological challenge we face from terrorism and aspects of extremism and the threat we face from those who promote these views.
- Provides practical help to prevent people from being drawn into terrorism and ensure they are given appropriate advice and support.
- Works with a wide range of sectors (including education, criminal justice, faith, charities, online and health) where there are risks of radicalisation that we need to deal with.
- Cover all forms of terrorism, including far right extremism and some aspects of non-violent extremism.

What we are doing in school

	P	Promotion of equality and diversity and positive relationships between students
	R	Referral of any concerns via the Safeguarding Lead to relevant authorities
	E	Education for students
	V	Vetting and removal of any posters or other materials of an extremist nature
	E	Environment - a safe & secure site with CCTV, sufficient security features and online filters
	N	News monitoring for any concerns in the locality
	T	Training of staff to raise awareness of the signs and risks
