



# A GUIDE TO YOUR SON'S ASSESSMENT REPORT AT WEST HILL SCHOOL

## Key Stage 3

Based on data from Key Stage 2, your son is placed into one of four 'Houses'. The table below shows the name of each house and what the target grades will be in Key Stage 4 for each house. Your son will not be given a target grade in Key Stage 3, he will follow a challenging programme of study that is matched to the ability of the house he is in.



House	Targets at Key Stage 4
Milton	8-9
Chaucer	6-8
Scott	4-6
Spenser	1-4

## Professional Projection Grading

For each subject, your son is graded: Green, Amber or Red for how well he is meeting the expectations of the work he has been set. Teachers grade your son based on the comments in the table below:

Green	...consistently meets and/or exceeds the expected standard of work
Amber	...occasionally meets the expected standard of work, but needs to be more consistent
Red	...rarely meets the expected standard of work
