Dear Parent/Guardian

Ski Holiday – Jay Peak, Vermont, USA **February 2022 (rescheduled due to 2021 cancellation)**

After our recent successful bi-annual ski holiday to Canada, we are intending to go back across the Atlantic and return to a resort we have been to before, Jay Peak in Vermont in the USA. Please note that this is a rescheduled trip due to the pandemic cancellation of the Easter 2021 trip. It is to the exact same resort as previous, but will be run over the February half-term instead.

The total cost of the 8-day holiday will be **£1,950** per pupil. This will include:

Return transatlantic flight from Manchester by scheduled airline
Coach transfer from the airport to and from Jay Peak
Half-board accommodation at the Hotel Jay in Jay Peak
5 day ski pass
5 day hire of quality skis/snowboards, boots and poles
5 x 5 hour lessons
Evening entertainment (Water Park, cinema, bowling, quiz nights etc.)
Excursion day in Boston (shopping opportunities and sight-seeing)
Insurance

We are able to arrange excellent rates for hire of ski/boarding trousers and jackets from a local supplier and advice regarding necessary kit and equipment will be given at a later date.

Ski lessons at 'Chill Factor^e' will also be offered nearer the time. A 6-hour course is available (taken over 3 – 6 weeks) at an approximate cost of £15 per person per visit; this includes transport, hire of equipment and instruction by a qualified instructor.
