Re: GCSE English Literature Set Texts. (Year 10)

As part of your son's GCSE English Literature course, he will study a 19th Century novel (A Christmas Carol by Charles Dickens); a modern text (An Inspector Calls by J B Priestley); a collection of Poems and a Shakespeare play (Macbeth).

Your son has now started to study A Christmas Carol by Charlie Dickens and some of the poems within the AQA Anthology. It is essential that your son has his own copy of the text which he can annotate in class and use for independent learning and revision at home.

Copies of the text can be purchased from any bookshop, but we would encourage students to buy from school because this ensures they will have the same edition that they will use in the classroom. As a school, we are able to purchase these books at a substantially reduced price compared to the retail price. Of course, we make no profit from the sale of books.

We also offer revision guides and workbooks to accompany the set text and the range of poetry that your son will study.

We will offer you the opportunity to purchase the modern text and Shakespeare play later in the academic year.
