Dear Parent/Carer,

Your child will be taking part in assessments starting on Monday 27th June that will last for two weeks. Some of these assessments will be in the form of mock exams that will take place in formal exam conditions and some will be practical based assessments in subject lesson time.

These assessments give us an opportunity to formally assess your child's progress towards their targets and also identify any gaps in their knowledge. Teachers will use this information to inform their planning as students move into year 11.

Your child's attendance, punctuality and effort is paramount throughout this assessment period as this will give them the best possible chance to achieve their potential.

Please encourage your child to revise at home. There will be material placed on google classrooms by class teachers to support revision and there are online platforms like mathswatch and Seneca learning that students can access too. Before each morning exam we ask that your child arrives to school at 8.15 to attend a breakfast session. Students will be provided with something to eat and spend some time with their class teachers for some preparations before they sit their exam that day.

Grades from these assessments will be sent home with your child's end of year report before we break for summer. If you have any concerns about your child's progress, please contact their subject teacher in the first instance.
