

Parental Code of Conduct

1. Respectful Communication

- Use **polite and respectful language** when speaking to all school staff, students, and other parents.
- Refrain from shouting, swearing, or abusive communication.
- Raise concerns **privately and calmly**, not via social media or in public spaces.

2. Model Positive Behaviour

- Be a role model for students in your conduct and attitude.
- Support the school's values—no smoking, vaping, alcohol, or inappropriate phone use on school premises or at events.
- Keep phones away during conversations or school gatherings.

3. Support School Policies

- Support the schools policies and procedures, including those where your child may receive a sanction
- Ensure your child arrives equipped, including a fully charged ipads and ipad pen.
- Avoid disruptive behaviour at assemblies, events, or during school visits.
- Comply with safeguarding laws and school expectations.
- Seek to clarify a child's version of events with the school's view in order to bring about a peaceful solution to any issue.

4. At Events and Visits

- Arrive and leave calmly—do not block entrances or fire exits.
- Follow directions from staff for safety and logistics.
- Photograph or film only when explicitly permitted by the school guidelines.

5. Social Media Use

- Do not publicly share complaints, images, or personal details about staff or students are incidents that have taken place at school or on school based activities.
- Avoid posting any content that is discriminatory, defamatory, or harmful.
- Use the correct school channel for complaints or concerns—not public platforms.
