Remote Education Policy

Purpose

This policy sets out the expectations and procedures for remote education to ensure that all students continue to access a high-quality education when learning from home. - Assignments and Deadlines: All assignments, projects, and assessments set on Showbie must be completed and submitted by the specified deadlines. Students are responsible for managing their time effectively to meet these requirements.
- Non-Submission: Failure to complete or submit work without a valid reason will be followed up in line with the school's assessment and behaviour policies.
- Attendance Monitoring: Attendance will be tracked through participation and activity on Showbie. Any concerns regarding attendance or engagement will be communicated to parents or guardians.
