Dear Parent/Carer

I wrote to you last week about the latest DFE Schools Guidance which stated that from Monday 7th June, "Schools should make appropriate judgements on the activities for their own pupils. This might not mean full-time provision and could include visits to education providers, independent study or remote provision combined with attendance in person".

Contained in this letter is the offer of combined on site and home learning that will take place from Monday 7^{th} June to Friday 18^{th} June for our Year 11 students.

In school sessions

Students should arrive 5 minutes before the start of their lesson and enter through the canteen gate where they will sign into school.

Home learning

Students will access their home learning through the year 11 google classroom.

Posted in the classroom will be links to the bridging units that have been uploaded to college websites. These units are aimed at supporting students to prepare for their studies and it will be beneficial for your child to complete these before they start their course in September.

Each day students will be expected to complete a short reflection task set by their form tutor about the bridging units they complete that day.

Exam results

As you are aware school are not allowed to share the Teacher Assessed Grades with students. Students will be able to access school on Thursday 12th August to pick up their grades. Details on the arrangements of results day will be sent out closer to the time and posted on our website and social media.
