- **Guided Choices Information and Parents' Evening:** Thursday 12th February 2026 An opportunity to speak to your child's teachers and learn about the process, understand the subjects on offer, and ask any questions you may have. You will make your class teacher appointments using Arbor and attend a presentation about Guided Choices. Presentations will start at 4pm and run every hour up to 7pm in the Drama Studio.
- **Guided Choices Booklet:** A comprehensive guide detailing the subjects available, course content, and assessment methods. This will be sent home on or after the Parents' Evening and made available on our school website.
- **Individual Guidance Sessions:** Your child will have the chance to meet with a member of staff to discuss their choices and receive tailored advice.

We encourage you to discuss the subject choices with your child and consider their preferences, academic strengths, and long-term goals. While we aim to accommodate all students' choices, some subjects may have limited spaces or specific entry requirements, which will be outlined during the process.

Please save the date for the Guided Choices Information Evening and ensure that you and your child attends.
