Re-Opening in January 2021 and Covid-19 Testing in Schools

Dear Parents and Carers.

I sincerely hope you have had an enjoyable Christmas with your families despite the pandemic and the increase in restrictions. I am writing to you with changes that were announced vesterday by Gavin Williamson, Secretary of State for Education. These changes bring with it challenges which we will continue to overcome together, ensuring that the education, health and well-being of our community remains our overarching priority.

All information included in this letter is subject to change given the nature of how the pandemic continues to evolve and the ever-changing nature of the information we receive from the Government.

Changes for the return to school in January 2021

The Government announced that there would be a further delay to the return to school for all secondary students.

Therefore, for clarity, I have outlined dates and who can return when below:

Tuesday 5th January – Friday 8th January

Face to face provision in school for secondary vulnerable children and those children whose parents/carers are classed as a keyworker.

Key worker parents should ensure that evidence of key worker status in sent in with the child as per previous correspondence.

Students in Year 11 should log into Google classrooms and access the google meet lessons using the timetable provided on page 4.

Students in Y7-10 should access Google Classrooms for each of their subjects and complete the activities provided. Students should follow their normal timetable to help with planning their time with each subject.

Monday 11th January – Friday 15th January

Face to face provision in school for Year 11.

Face to face provision in school for secondary vulnerable children and those children whose parents/carers are classed as a keyworker.

Students in Y7-10 should access Google Classrooms for each of their subjects and complete the activities provided. Google meet lessons will take place as per the timetables included on page 5 onwards.

Monday 18th January onwards

Return to school planned for all children to re-start face to face teaching

Free School Meals

If your child currently receives a free school meal a collection point is available for you to collect a grab bag. Please contact the main office to book a collection.

Mass testing programme update

The purpose of the further delay is to give schools more time to set up and roll out the mass testing programme which we still have very limited information on. We are yet to receive the training packages and lateral flow tests so we certainly could not have been ready for January 4th as the Government had planned. We are hoping for more clarity over the next few days so that we can use Monday 4th January to intensively plan and train up a workforce to subsequently set up and roll out the programme.

The intention is to provide mass lateral flow testing for secondary age students. Nothing is more important than ensuring the health and safety of our students, families, staff and the wider community, so this is something we welcome as a positive step forward.

However, schools are still awaiting specific details and guidance from the government, in particular around logistical issues. Schools have been given very little notice to prepare and implement such a large-scale event in time for the first day back in January but we wanted to give you notice of what we currently do know and our initial thoughts.

In summary, there are two phases of testing from the information we have:

The initial phase is to attempt to test as many staff and students as possible on return to school in January known as 'Mass testing.' This will involve offering two tests, 3 days apart to every student and member of school staff during January.

We will aim to test as many staff and students within our available capacity but this will be based on the resources that the school is provided with and the workforce that is available to undertake such a specialist task.

The first priority for this mass testing is to test all Year 11 students to ensure they are in the best position possible to commence their exams, which for some begin on 11th January 2021. In order for this to happen we are inviting all Year 11 students to attend school, reporting to the Main Office, for their tests week commencing 4th January 2021 as follows:

Students with exams on Monday 11th January 2021:

Test one: Tuesday 5th January 2021 between 11am and 1pm Test two: Friday 8th January 2021 between 10am and 12noon

All other Year 11 Students

Test one: Friday 8th January 2021 between 12.30pm and 2pm

Test two: This will take place on Monday 11th January 2021 as Year 11 return to school (should this date change we will communicate alternative arrangements accordingly)

IMPORTANT: All testing will require your consent before your child is tested.

Due to timescales, we are asking all Year 11 parents to provide consent via the Parentpay platform. The item will show in your "Pay for other items" as a free item on your account and can be accessed via the following link. https://app.parentpay.com/public/client/security/

If you do not have access to Parentpay please send in signed, written consent with your child when they attend for their test.

Year Groups 7 to 10

We will communicate arrangements for mass testing of all other year groups week commencing 4th January 2021.

The next phase, known as 'serial testing.'

This is where we can offer tests to children who have been named as 'close contacts' but are asymptomatic. Students who are identified as 'close contacts' would normally have to isolate at home for 10 days but serial testing means that students can stay in school and not have to isolate at home unless they have a positive test result. This is very useful to schools and I very much welcome its introduction as it will significantly reduce the need for students to needlessly isolate at home along with managing the upset that is caused by being named as a contact and losing face to face learning time. I also see serial testing as much more manageable than mass testing in schools which of course is a huge undertaking without any additional support, such as that of the armed forces.

More information will hopefully be provided to parents and carers at the start of the new term in January However, there are many levels of planning and arrangements needed to be resolved first before we can successfully do this as a school community given the time and resources constraints that have been placed before us. As I previously outlined, all information included in this letter is subject to change. I will of course keep you updated. Please follow our social media pages and website for further updates.
