## Reception, Year 1 and 2

- Dark grey school trousers, skirt, pinafore or shorts
- White **POLO** shirt - no tie required
- Navy blue V-neck jumper - **Please note that these must now have the school logo on**
- ALL BLACK school **shoes/trainers** (leather / leather-look ankle boots may be worn in **WINTER**), shoes should be flat and have backs in for Health and Safety reasons
- Summer term: Blue gingham check **DRESS** - optional. **No playsuits**
- PE KIT— currently provided by Westminster Primary Academy
- Book Bag

## Years 3, 4, 5 and 6

- Dark Grey school trousers, skirt, pinafore or shorts
- White buttoned school shirt with collar
- Navy blue V-neck jumper. - **Please note that these must now have the school logo on**
- ALL BLACK school **shoes/trainers** (leather / leather-look ankle boots may be worn in **WINTER**), shoes should be flat and have backs in for Health and Safety reasons
- Summer term: Blue gingham check **DRESS** - optional. **No playsuits**
- Tie - the new ties are now full ties as lots were damaged last year. Children will need to learn how to tie these!
- PE KIT— currently provided by Westminster Primary Academy
- Book Bag

We would ask that SOCKS and TIGHTS are plain and dark in colour, (grey and black).

**We do expect that all children will wear ALL BLACK shoes/trainers in school, as detailed above.**

Please could all items of uniform and coats be CLEARLY NAMED as it is far easier to reunite items with the owner if this is done.

### **Lost Property.**

Whilst we will always try our best to find lost property, it is not always possible and school cannot accept responsibility for lost items.

Children are given clear instructions by classt eachers on where jumpers and coat should be placed when they take these items off in school.
