

Following on from Mr Farley's letter here is a list of websites we use in school that you can access from home and specific instructions for each site if needed.

These are not for your children to spend all day on but a selection of activities as an option. Other work is available on Class Dojo (all classes) and Google Classroom (Y3-6). They can write stories (literacyshed.com have some great story starters), make up their own maths calculations, draw, do a mini project on a topic of their choice OR READ A BOOK.

Ideally they would complete at least **3 lots of 15 mins on Lexia, and RM Easimath** each week and **15 minutes a day on Active Learn** (Bug Club)
