Many have accessed activities that they have not tried previously and visited out of Blackpool for the first time. Day trip all 60 children access Beacon fell over 2 day trips. Day trip - all Y3 60 children accessed a full day of activities on land and the lake. Three day residential - School to supplement the Y6 trip for coach and £40 for all pupils. (Some funding available for PP children)
Transport	To ensure children are able to participate in a range of intra competitions across the town. Buses and Taxis when minibus not available.	£1000	Already the range of outside clubs, competitions and activities entered has increased on the previous years. Whole of Autumn term = 6 intra-school events, 15 inter-school events with a total of 148 participations. Spring Term = 10 intra-school events, 27 inter-school events with a total of 301 participations. Summer Term (end of year) = 15 intra-school events, 39 inter-school events with a total of 703 participations. Inclusive of youth games. Following all the clubs and events entered this school year Gateway has been awarded the Sports Mark Gold Award.
