Sometimes people offer to help at FoW events and then don't hear from us. Understandably they get a bit annoyed and don't bother offering again. This doesn't happen on purpose – we really do need lots of helpers (although for some events we have too many and some events not enough!).

There are a few reasons we might not have got back to you...

- People scribble numbers on a response sheet, when we try and contact you we can't decipher the number or the message doesn't go through.
- It's not always one person sorting the volunteers and everyone has a different way of handling how they get helpers.
- We sometimes miss Facebook messages, or someone offers to help on the playground and we forget in the rush of getting our own kids into school.

We're always trying to improve things – we're now making our volunteer coordinators work in the same way and contact everyone who offered to help. And we now have the online system so we can easily track helpers and contact them.

On the night of events it can be a bit chaotic (which is why we ask you to turn up early) but we're always grateful for the help. Our events depend on parent volunteers so if you can spare time please do help.

New online ticket system – PTA events

We've listened to your feedback about events and we want to try and make things better. So to simplify ticketing for FoW events (such as the disco, cinema), reduce confusion & paperwork and make life easier for the school office we're using a new online system called PTA events. Just go to: https://www.pta-events.co.uk/friendsofwhitefield

- Register for an account (takes 5 minutes and you only have to do this once)
- Buy a ticket for events we are running
- Pay online using their secure payment system
- Let us know here if your child has any dietary requirements
- You can also sign up to volunteer

This is a secure system and ensures we have all the information we need to run events smoothly. The Friends of Whitefield are completely separate from school so we don't have access to school information such as phone numbers and allergies. Unless you are really struggling with the system **please** don't pay through the school office.
