Sports Day Update

We have been closely monitoring the weather forecast for Monday, and temperatures are expected to reach up to 32°C. In light of this, and with the safety and wellbeing of the children as our top priority, we have made some changes to our Sports Day plans.

We will no longer be holding a full day of Sports Day. We will proceed with the morning session at Chiswick School, as originally planned. However, the afternoon session at The William Hogarth School will not go ahead due to safeguarding concerns related to the extreme heat in the afternoon.

The revised Sports Day will now take place from 10:00am to 12:00pm at Chiswick School, and we warmly welcome and encourage parents and carers to attend and support the children during this time.

To ensure children stay safe and hydrated, there will be two water break stations available on site. Please make sure your child:

- ✓ Brings a filled water bottle
- ✓ Has applied sun cream before arriving
- ✓ Brings a hat and sun cream with them on the day

Regarding the cancelled afternoon session, we hope to reschedule it in the coming weeks. If this is not possible, we will look to hold the events at the start of the next school year as a welcome-back celebration.
