The School Day

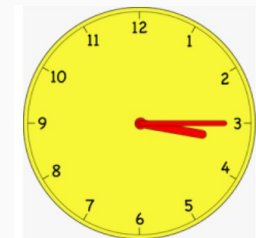


- Soft start between **8:45- 8:55 am**.

Extended Provision



Breakfast club

- From 07:45
- Provided with a light breakfast snack (cereal, toast)
- £5 (£4 for siblings)
- Children escorted to their classroom for the start of the school day

After school care

- 3:30 - 5:30 (£10 per session)
- 3:30 - 6:00 (£15 per session)
- Snack provided

Salad bar and dessert

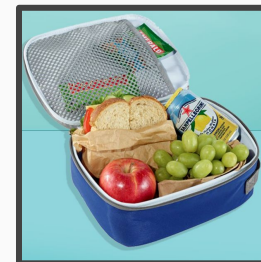

Read Write Inc.



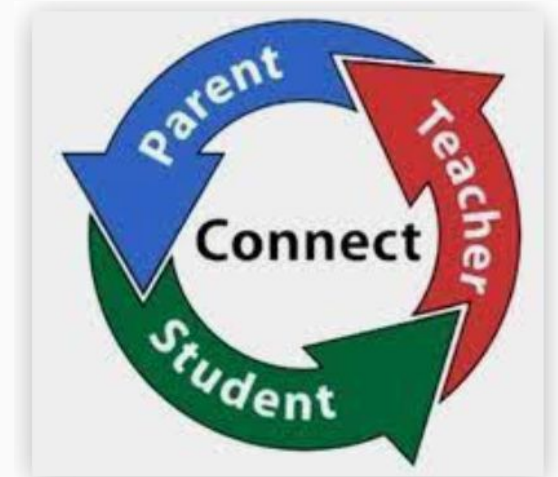
Child initiated learning in the afternoons covering themes such as Transport, Our World, Farm Animals, etc.

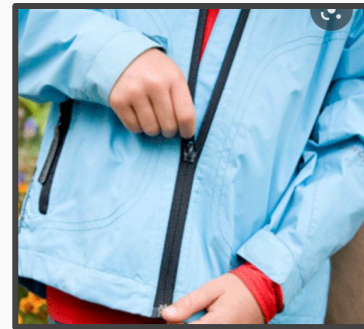
Start Dates
