For words that end in <u>one vowel</u> then <u>one consonant</u>, the final consonant is usually **doubled** before a <u>suffix beginning with a vowel</u> if the <u>last</u> syllable is stressed.

Forget <u>forgett</u>able Admit <u>admitt</u>ing Begin <u>beginn</u>er
