1) Rule 22: Explanation

The 'shun' sound at the end of a word is can be spelt 'tion', 'sion', 'cian' or 'ssion' (Rule 17).

'cian' is often for occupations (jobs).

'ssion' is often used if the root word ends in 'ss', 'mit' or 'cede' / 'ceed'.
