Our PSHE will be about 'Dreams and Goals'. This will include developing a positive attitude and helping each other achieve their goals.

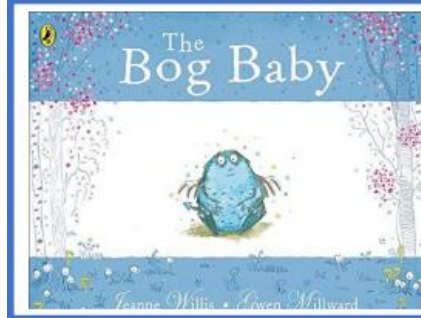


## RE

## English

## Science

In science we will be learning all about the use of everyday **Materials**.

The children will investigate the different purposes of materials based on their properties.



## P.E.

In PE we will be learning about dance related to the Great Fire of London and Yoga.



## Humanities

In our history topic 'The Great Fire of London' we will research about what happened in 1666. We will create a timeline of events and assess the impact of the fire on London.



## Computing

This term our project will be 'Digital Photography'.

The children will learn how to:

- Recognise ways to capture photographs.
- Capture, edit and improve photographs.
- Understand that images seen may not be real.

## Music

Making Music – children will learn to recognise rhythmical patterns and will continue to develop their understanding of rhythmic notation using props



and actions.

## Art and cooking

We will be in two groups alternating weekly art and cooking. The dishes we will make include cinnamon toast crunch, ratatouille and strawberry mousse.
