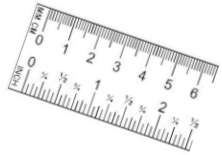




Why our world is wonderful

This term we will be learning about multiplication and division and learning to measure length and height, mass, capacity and temperature.

Our PSHE will be about 'Healthy Me'. This will include learning about healthy eating and making healthy friendships.

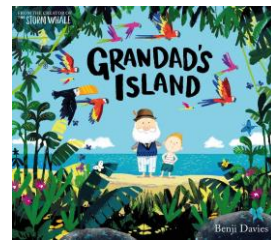


RE

This half term will begin to understand 'What is a prophet'. The children will be investigating stories that show the characteristics of a prophet and what a prophet might mean to some people; identifying similarities between prophets across varying worldviews and what this suggests about their importance to some people.

English

Our focus text this half-term is called 'Grandad's Island' by Benji Davies. The genres we will be writing are: a return narrative, an information text on jungle animals and a creative writing piece. Our story time book is The Nothing to See Here Hotel.



Science

In science we will continue learning about materials. This will include ship building.



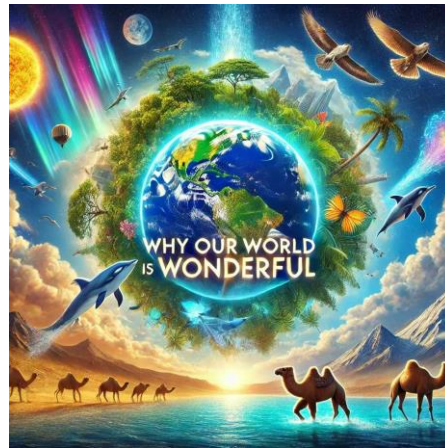
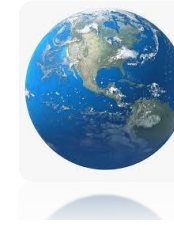
P.E.

In PE we will be playing target games and invasion games.



Humanities

In our geography topic 'Why our World is wonderful' we will learn the capital cities of the UK and the human and physical features found around the UK. We will also be able to explain the differences between oceans and seas.



Computing

This half term the children will be focusing on information technology as they produce 'Pictograms'. They will recognise that we can count objects using tally charts and Organise data in a pictogram. Then be able to explain that we can present information using a computer.

Music

World music – we will explore folk music through singing, dancing, and playing percussion.



Art and D&T

In our topic expressive paintings, Children explore primary colours and secondary colours through expressive mark making, connecting colour, mark making and texture (of paint) through abstract work.
