






'u' sound spelt 'ou'

Notes

Many other words can be created by adding **prefixes** and/or **suffixes** to the examples given here, e.g. *doubling*

Be careful: prefixes and suffixes can sometimes change the sound that **'ou'** makes, e.g. south > southern
