
Thank you from myself and my team for all your support and encouragement.

CLUB INFORMATION

HALF TERM

Clubs will run for 10 weeks, week commencing 13th January through to week commencing 24th March 2025.

If your child was on a club for the Autumn Term and wants to continue through to the Spring Term, you must rebook them. No child has a confirmed place from one term to the next.

Bookings are on a first come first served basis. Each club has a maximum number of children that can participate therefore, please book and pay promptly on ParentPay to secure your child's place.

Pupil Premium Grant/FSM - We have 2 Pupil Premium Grant/FSM places reserved for each club. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium Grant/FSM and they would like to join a club, please send an email to the admin team (admin@hogarth.hounslow.sch.uk) and state which club you would like to book your child on. We will then contact you directly to confirm if the space is available or offer an alternative club.

Tax Free Childcare vouchers - If you would like to pay by your Tax Free Childcare Account, please send an email to the admin team (admin@hogarth.hounslow.sch.uk) and state which club you would like to book. We will then contact you directly to confirm the space and arrange payment.

Uniform - Children must have their P.E. kits for Dance, Gymnastics and Football.

Refunds – refunds are only provided if a club does not run and is cancelled by school. Fees cannot be refunded if a child changes their mind or if a day is missed due to absences.




