Message from the Headteacher

Dear Families,

It was lovely to see so many of you at our 'Meet Your Teacher' events this week and last. I know that you will have enjoyed being able to come into school to do this in person, rather than via a Google Meet link. Please do not worry if you were unable to attend the meetings, all of the information will go up onto the website in the relevant year group areas.

I am keen to build further community engagement with our school's ongoing development and improvement strategy this year. To help with this, I will be giving snapshots of our school's priorities and aims against each of the Education Inspection Framework headings as we move through the school year, together with highlights of what we have achieved and whether we are on track to achieve our goals. I will also be sending a questionnaire for parents to complete to provide their views about the school. This will help us to make sure that our goals and priorities remain aligned. Looking at the 'Quality of Education' area, we are clear that this year our efforts need to be focused on getting writing right and refreshing our Design and Technology curriculum. Writing is the area of children's learning that was hit hardest by COVID and remote learning – it is where we saw the biggest learning deficits. As a school though, getting writing right is more than just catching up as a result of COVID. It is about making sure that the pedagogy is outstanding, the stimulus materials are outstanding, the curriculum sequencing is outstanding and the children's learning is outstanding.

Over the past few years, children have enjoyed participating in the Reading Challenge on the website. This year, we are reviewing the challenge so that it encourages children to read a range of different genre, rather than simply looking at the number of books read. Thank you to Miss Jones who has also refreshed our recommended reads for each year group – these are on the website too. To ensure that we have a good stock of these recommended reads in school, these books will also be prioritised in our Amazon Wishlist.

The autumn weather is extremely changeable – torrential downpours to blazing sunshine! Please make sure that your child has a coat and a jumper in school with them so that they can play outside comfortably every day. Thank you for your help with this.

During the week of 27th September, we will be holding our annual Harvest Assembly in school to support local charity: The Upper Rooms. I know the Upper Rooms are always so grateful to receive your donations of dried and canned goods, as well toiletries so please do send your contributions into school with your child. Each year group will be performing either a poem or a song for the assembly which will be recorded and uploaded to the website for you to enjoy.




Year 4
