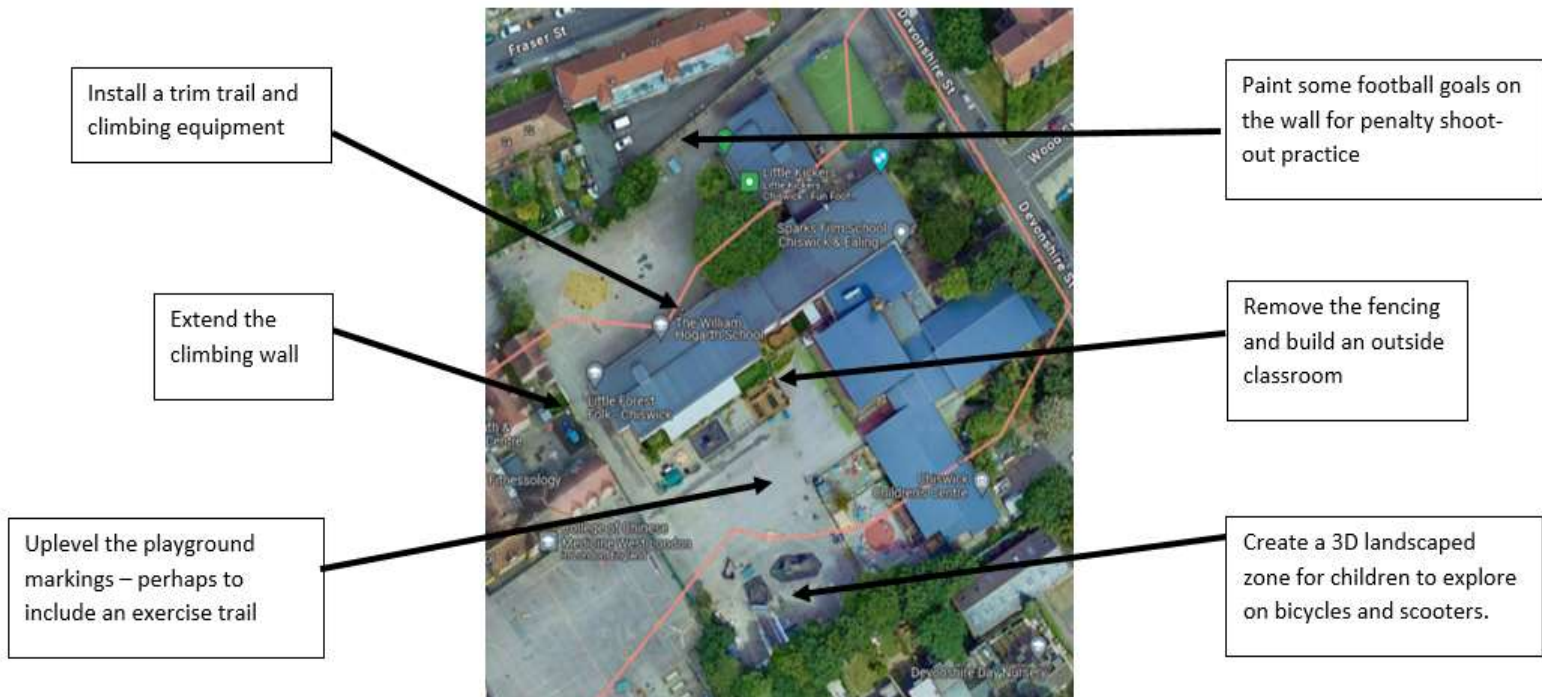

### **Message from Ms Stockley**

Dear Families,

What a wonderful start to the summer term (aside from the weather)!

This week, I had a very productive meeting with the FOWHS Playground Refurbishment Committee – an essential aspect of our whole school improvement plans. The team were so creative and constructive, bringing ideas and enthusiasm to the table and constantly focusing on the children’s ambitions for their playground. This followed on from successful meetings I held with the Local Authority just prior to and during the Easter break about the support they will be offering with this vital work. I know that the FOWHS team will be reaching out to share more detail about the discussion, the options we explored and our next steps in this improvement programme. I have popped some of the ideas we spoke about onto the plan below – do please let one of the representatives know any ideas you and your child think of as well.



We are about to launch a new enrichment initiative in school to encourage the children to explore and develop their creativity. Each month, I will introduce an ‘Artist of the Month’ in Friday’s celebration assembly (I will also make a note in the newsletter as well). Children will be able to create a piece of art that is influenced by, or that references the artist’s work, ready to submit at the end of the month. We will be establishing a new pupil leadership group - Hogarth Art Critics – who will review all the submissions and select the winning entry from each category:

- Early Years,
- Key Stage 1
- Lower Key Stage 2
- Upper Key Stage 2

The winning work will be displayed in frames in a central location - of course there will be certificates as well. I am really looking forward to seeing all of the children’s fantastic efforts.

**Financial Help**

**Free Money for Childcare and After-School Clubs and Holiday Camps**

It is a really difficult time at the moment with bills, rent and food prices all soaring. At The William Hogarth School, we are continually looking at ways to help out our community and try to alleviate some of the pressures families are facing.


**Tax-Free Childcare** which is a government scheme to help working families with the costs of childcare is something that could help you with current costs. It is not only for 15/30 hours free childcare for nursery aged children (if entitled) but

also includes wrap around provision such as **breakfast and after-school care** as well as **after-school clubs** for children up to the age of 11.

Tax-Free Childcare is a bank account that is set up in your child's name and for every £8 you put in, the government will top up with another £2 - up to a maximum of £2000 a year. You must pay out to an organisation that is Ofsted registered - (schools and lots of sports clubs are) and then you pay for your provision through the scheme. If you earn under £100,000, it is likely that you are eligible to claim.

As we are all aware, school budgets are stretched and we are always looking for ways to increase our resources in our school so that we can provide the best possible educational experience for your child. This may include trips and clubs.

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:


- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Please note that part of school funding is based on how many families receive free school meals. If we can increase the numbers, we increase our funding eligibility. Simple!!!



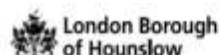

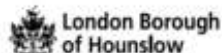
