

Maths

This term our focus will be on Addition and Subtraction and Shape. We will be using number lines and base 10 to learn how to add and subtract. We will practice our fluency in the 2 times tables and division facts.



PSHE

Our PSHE will be about 'Celebrating Difference'. This will include challenging gender stereotypes, learning about bullying and supporting diversity.

RE

This half term our key question is: What do candles mean to people? We will look at their association with Diwali, Advent and Hanukah.



English

Our English book this half term is the Night Gardener. From this story we will be writing a setting description and a diary entry.



Science

In science we will continue our focus on animals including humans.

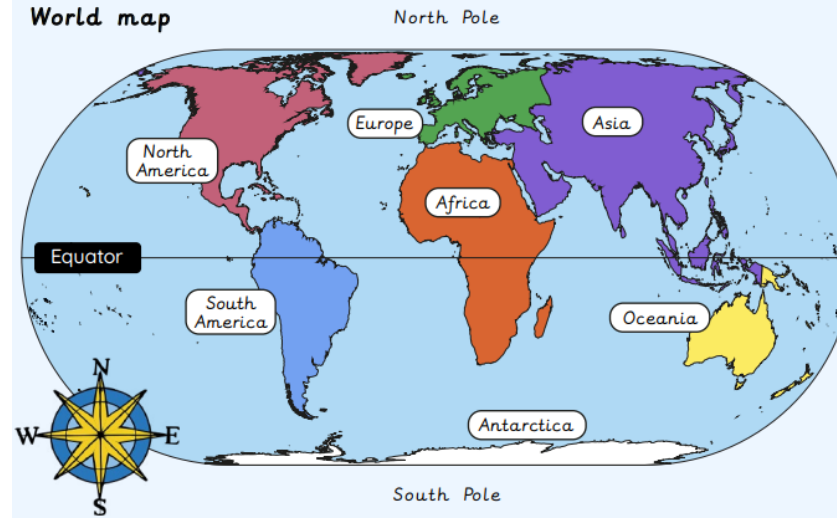
We will participate in a series of exercises and investigate how each exercise: makes your body feel, affects your breathing and uses each of your muscles.



P.E.

In PE we focus on gymnastics – Pathways: straight, zigzag and curving. Children will perform a variety of moves on the floor and on apparatus using different pathways. Children will demonstrate determination and perseverance.

Humanities

In this unit we are exploring hot and cold places. We are learning to name and locate the seven continents, the North and South Poles, and the equator on a world map. We will also investigate the weather, writing about it using key vocabulary and explaining whether we live in a hot or cold place.

Computing

Our project will be about Robot Algorithms. We will design routes for BeeBots and debug errors when our plan doesn't work.



Music

In music the children delve deeper into rhythm exploration, with a focus on stick notation. This unit corresponds with the curriculum's emphasis on building rhythm skills. Pupils learn to interpret and read rhythms using stick notation.
