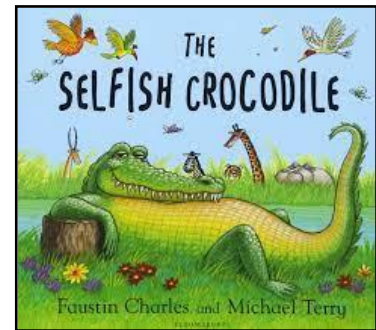






Our focus story this week is:
