
Next week, children in Years 3 to 5 will be sitting Autumn Term assessments, so I am pleased to be able to report back on outcomes and progress from last academic year, now that the Fisher Family Trust dashboard reports have been completed for Years 2 and 6. Although national tests were not sat for these end of key stage year groups, all the children at our school completed standardised testing in school under formal SATs conditions, to monitor their progress and lockdown learning deficits. We are very delighted that William Hogarth children in Key Stage 1 achieved at least in line with national averages for Reading, Writing and Maths at expected standard and significantly better than the national average at the higher standard. Likewise, progress for these pupils was significantly above the national.
