Message from the Headteacher

Friday is such a wonderful day in school, largely because we always begin the afternoon with a celebration of the week, whether of children's learning, accomplishments, efforts or the way that they live our school values, making them a reality of our culture and ethos. One of the most brilliant elements of this afternoon's assembly was the absolute delight that the children took in celebrating their friends' and their peers' triumphs and successes – pure magic and serendipitous given that our value of the week is 'Togetherness'.

I had a very successful meeting with the board of the Friends of William Hogarth School yesterday afternoon. For some of our older children, you will remember the Friday Fun Days and School Fayres that this incredible team of dedicated volunteers used to organise to support fund-raising activities for the school. I am pleased to report back that we have agreed to relaunch some of these events as we move forward. We have also been ordering numbers from smallest to greatest, and greatest to smallest!



1 is the smaller number.
