A little bit about Doodle

Doodle builds confidence and ability in maths and English by creating every child a personalised work programme tailored to their strengths and weaknesses. Using Doodle for just 10 minutes a day is proven to help children make three months of progress in just one month!

How to get started

1. Watch the following video with your child/ren: <https://vimeo.com/398785961>.
2. Download the **DoodleMaths** app onto an Apple, Android or Amazon device. You can also log in to the Doodle programmes through Doodle's website (doodlemaths.com) on laptops and desktops by clicking 'log in' and choosing the correct programme. Follow the instructions in the video above for more information on how to log in.
3. Use the **maths class code** that matches your child's class provided by their teacher. You can use the same login details to access **DoodleTables**.
4. If your child's teacher has also given you an **English class code**, repeat steps 2 and 3 for **DoodleEnglish**, but **make sure you choose 'my child already has a Doodle account' and enter the username and password you have just set up in DoodleMaths**. Use these same login details to access DoodleSpell.

- Link your email to your child's account by asking your child to log in to DoodleMaths and tap on **Grown Ups**, or visit parents.doodlemaths.com and follow the instruction in this link: help.doodlehq.com/en/articles/2892158-how-to-link-a-parent-account-to-a-child-s-school-account
- You'll then be able to view your child's progress by visiting parents.doodlemaths.com or by downloading the free **DoodleConnect** app on an Apple or Android device.
