This will help us to:



- Signpost you to testing
- Closely monitor the adult and other children in your child's BUBBLE
- Offer advice to other parents in your child's BUBBLE.



**Your child can wear:**

- School uniform, or
- School PE kit

The weather forecast is good and we will be spending as much time as possible outside, so you might want to include a cap or sunhat.



Your child **MUST** bring a **NAMED water bottle** to school every day. This will come home every day.



Chartwells will be in school, cooking fresh, hot lunches.

Your child **CAN** bring:

- Personal hand sanitiser
- Pack of tissues
- Suncream (wipes are good for little ones)
- A piece of fruit / chopped vegetable for a snack

If your child prefers a packed lunch, this is fine, but it must be in a disposable container as it will be thrown away straight after eating.

- Scooting.



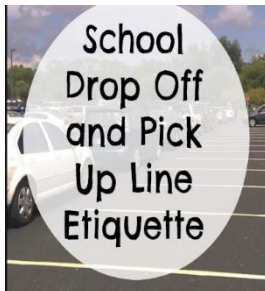
If you must travel by public transport, remember to wear gloves and face masks.

**You will not be able to drop items into school during the day or pop into the office.**

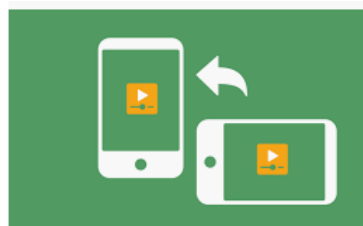
