

Year 1 Summer 1

Maths

This term we will look at measurement including length and height and weight and mass. We will begin to learn about multiplication and division through grouping and sharing.

Throughout our lessons, we have an element of problem solving and reasoning. Children will apply their mathematical knowledge and use manipulatives and resources to demonstrate their understanding, deepen thinking and develop mastery.



English

As well as our daily RWI phonics lessons, we will be learning about a range of text types this term. These include:

Traditional Tale Narrative

Character description

Instructions

These text types will be used in a cross curricular manner across all subjects.



PSHE

In PSHE our focus is relationships. We will talk about our family and friends, and people who help us and how to greet people appropriately. We will also learn how to be our own best friend!

RE

In the summer term our focus religion is Judaism. The theme for this half term is Shabbat and our key question is: Is Shabbat important to Jewish children?

Computing

In Computing we will be introduced to data and information. Labelling, grouping and searching are important aspects of data and information. This unit of work focuses on assigning data (images) with different labels in order to demonstrate how computers are able to group and present data. During this unit, we will be logging on to the computers, opening their documents, and saving their documents.

Science

This half term we are learning all about plants. We will learn how plants grow by planting our own kidney bean seed and observing the changes over time. We will also learn about the different parts of trees and discover the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees.

P.E.

This half term we will be focusing on target games and invasion game skills to develop co-ordination skills and help with their general development.



Humanities

Our History focus this half term is travel and transport. We will reflect on different forms of modern transport and how much has changed over time by creating historical timelines. We will focus on some key transports 'firsts' and how they have changed lives and whether everyone welcomed change and saw it in a positive light.

Music

We have music lessons with a specialist music teacher every Thursday morning. These lessons cover rhythm and pulse, pitch, singing games and instrumental activities.

Art

This half term is all about plasticine. We will be creating our own plasticine models and decorated plinths inspired by the book 'Dirty Beasts' by Roald Dahl and illustrated by Quentin Blake.
