How to get started

1. Watch the following video with your child/ren: <https://vimeo.com/398785961>.
2. Download the **DoodleMaths** app onto an Apple, Android or Amazon device. You can also log in to the Doodle programmes through Doodle's website (doodlemaths.com) on laptops and desktops by clicking 'log in' and choosing the correct programme. Follow the instructions in the video above for more information on how to log in.
3. Use the **username and password** provided by your child's teacher to log in to Doodle. You can use the same login details to access **DoodleTables**.
4. Repeat steps 2-3 with **DoodleEnglish** and **DoodleSpell** if your child's teacher has let you know that you'll also be using these programmes.
