These text types will be used in a cross curricular manner across all subjects. We will also be following the **Read Write** Inc. Scheme in Phonics.


Science

Our topic this term is 'Everyday materials which will provide an exciting introduction to chemistry. It will allow us to explore the properties of materials,

for example, which materials are waterproof, what materials to use when building a wall. We will learn important scientific skills such as questioning and observation and about how to use simple equipment to perform tests safely.

P.E.

This term we will take a multiskills approach to learning through activities that are fundamentals of movement. This approach focuses on the development of movement, balance and coordination. We will also be doing gymnastic working wide, narrow and curled types of rolling and working on our balance.



Computing

We will develop our understanding of the various aspects of using a computer to create and manipulate text, becoming more familiar with using a keyboard and mouse to enter and remove text. Finally, we will consider the differences between using a computer to create text, and writing text on paper.



Topic

Our topic this term is 'Locality'. This is a geography based topic where children will complete simple fieldwork and observational skills. They will be to studying the geography of The William Hogarth School and its ground and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.

Music

In music we will learn and we have music lessons with a specialist music teacher every Thursday morning.

These lessons cover rhythm and pulse, pitch, singing games and instrumental activities.





This term we will spend time on developing basic cooking skills such as measuring, pouring and mixing. They will also be making simple slides and levers for a moving story book.
