

Year 1

Maths

In Maths we are looking at place value up to 20, followed by addition and subtraction to 20. Children will apply their mathematical knowledge and use manipulatives and resources to demonstrate their understanding, deepen thinking and develop mastery.



PSHE

Our PSHE this term will continue 'Think Equal' and are reading books that reflect the changing topics of each week.

RE

We will investigate the roles of God through stories and sacred texts, children will look at the things God does and what this means to different people.



English

We will be learning about a range of text types this term. These include: Recounts, Instructions, Letter writing, Descriptions and Information books

These text types will be used in a cross curricular manner across all subjects. We will also be following the **Read Write Inc. Scheme in Phonics.**



Topic

Our topic this term is 'Memory Box'. This is a history-based topic where children can examine aspects of the past. Children will be able to look back at their own memories of family and of when they were younger, as well as create new and exciting memories.

Computing

We will explore using individual commands, both with other learners, and as part of a computer program. We will identify what each floor command does and use that knowledge to start predicting the outcome of programs.



Science

Our topic this term is 'Animals including humans'. Children will be learning about food chains, types of animals and their diets. We will learn important scientific skills such as questioning and observation and about how to use simple equipment to perform tests safely.



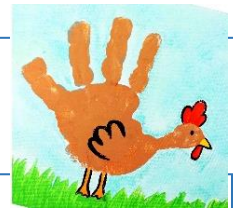
P.E.
