### **Write a Diary Entry:**

Pretend to be a famous medieval monarch like William the Conqueror or Eleanor of Aquitaine.

Write a day in their life, including events like battles, feasts, or important decisions.

### **Design a Royal Coat of Arms:**

Research the symbols and colors used in medieval heraldry.

Design a personal coat of arms for a chosen monarch or create one for yourself as a "medieval ruler."

### **Model of a Castle:**

Build a medieval castle using recycled materials, LEGO, or paper mâché. Label key parts like the keep, moat, and drawbridge.

Bonus: Include a mini monarch figure!

### **Interview time**

Interview a medieval Monarch. Ask them why they believe they were the most powerful

### **"Who's Who" Poster:**

Create a poster featuring several medieval monarchs, each with a short description of their achievements and challenges. Can your peers guess who is who?
