**A note on this report:** The data for this report was provided on the basis of consent and was accurate at the time of downloading (see date above). The report only includes information for people allocated to the board's constitution.

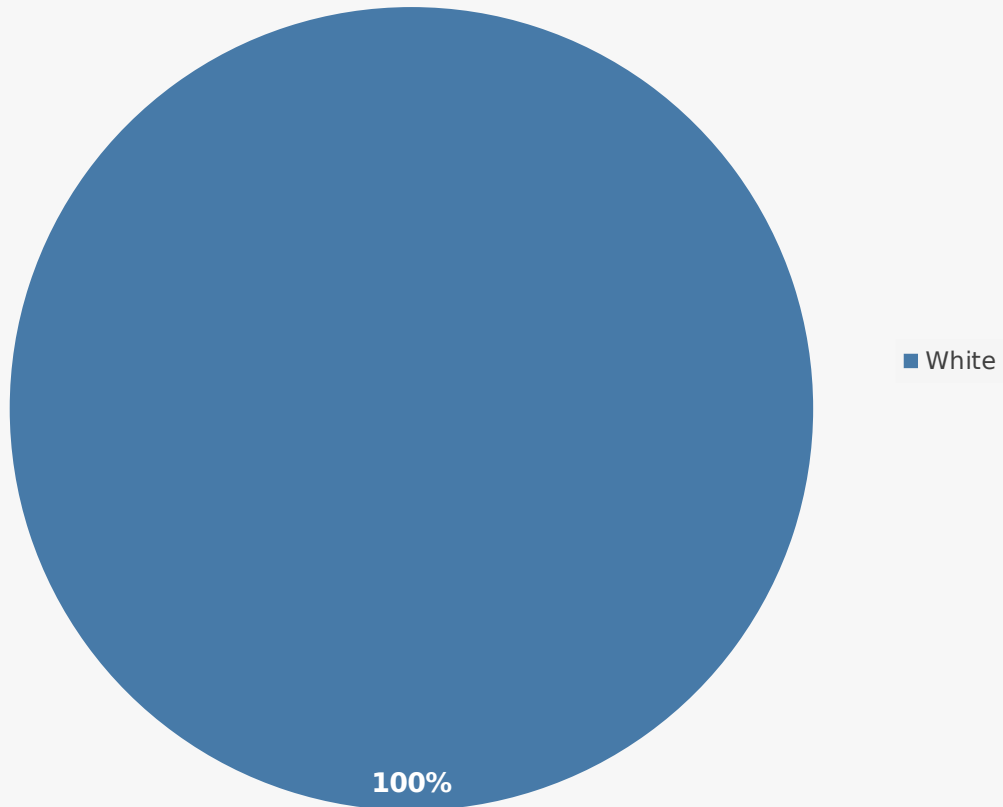

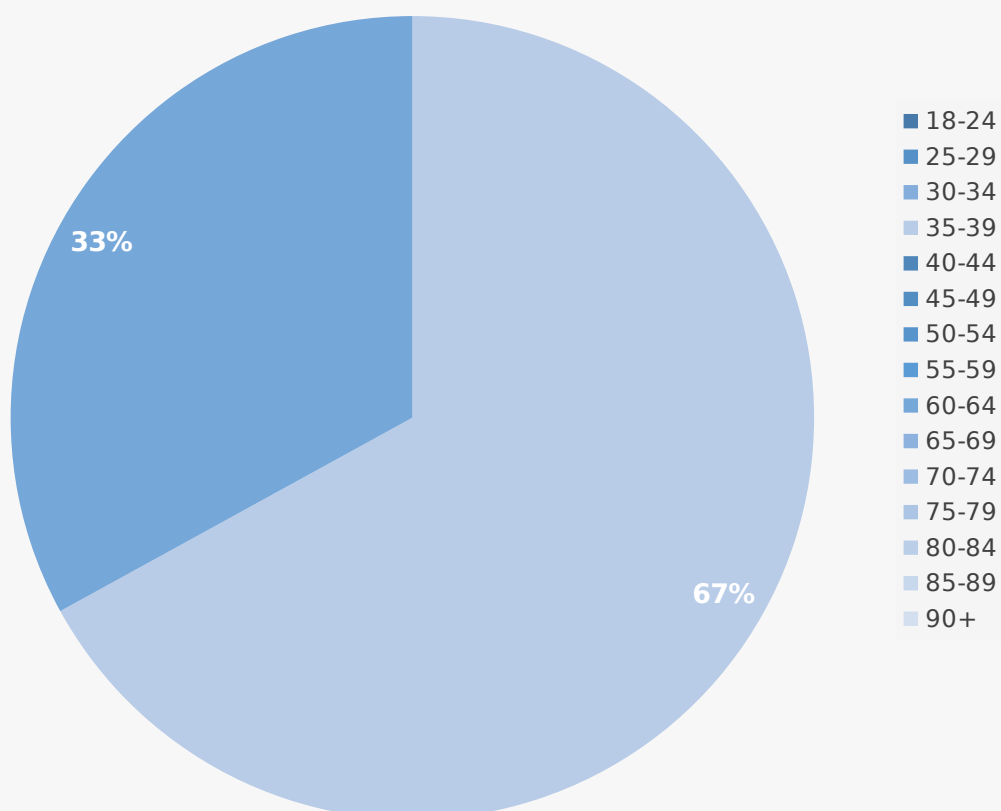

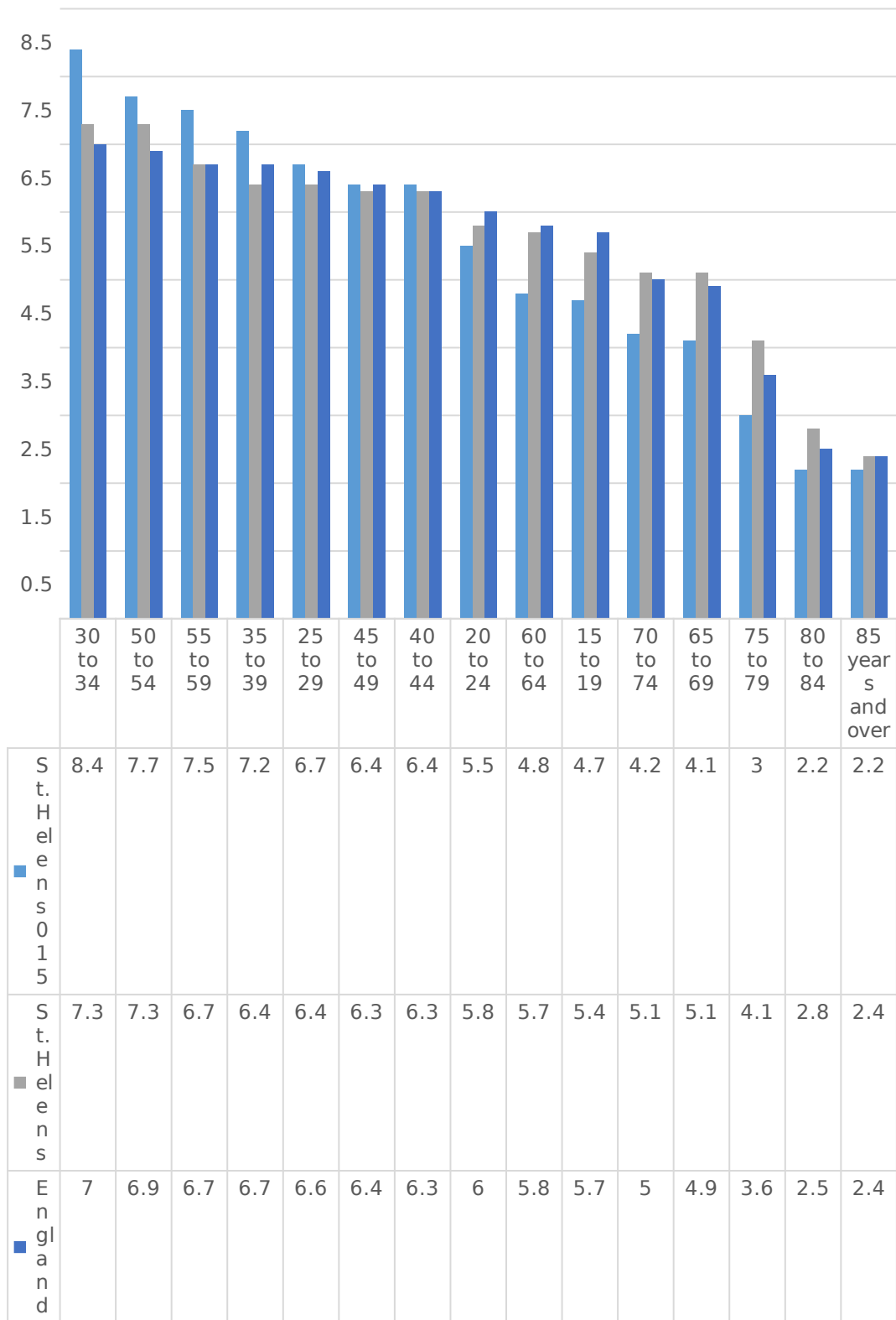

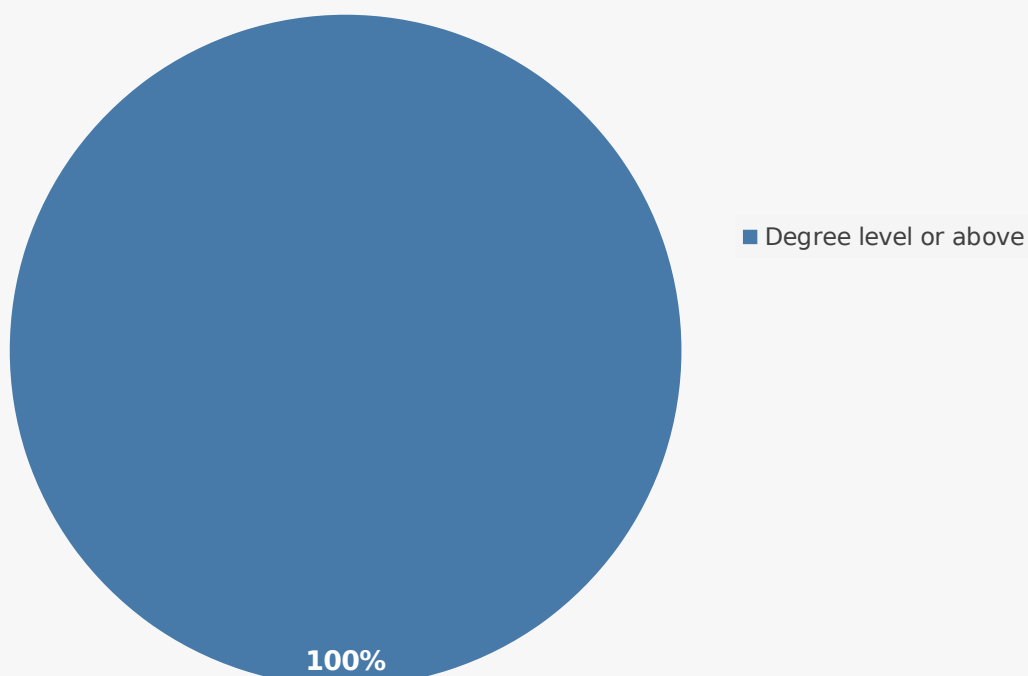

## Census data: Age by five-year age band

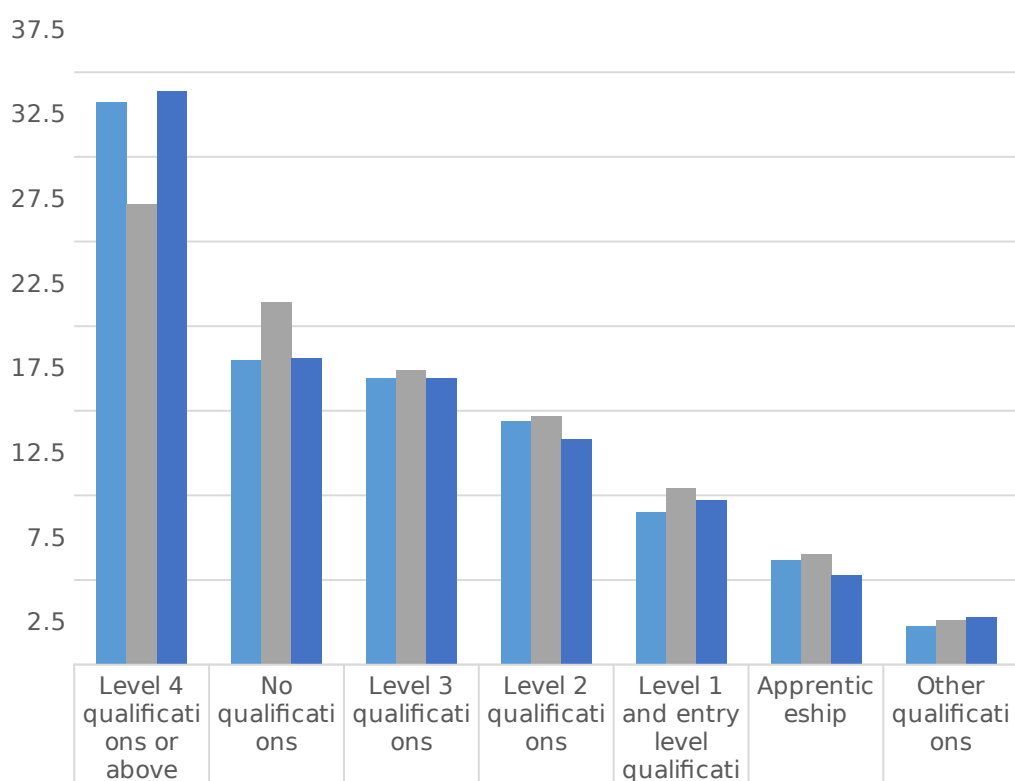


**What is the highest level of education qualification you have achieved (either in England, the wider UK or elsewhere)?**



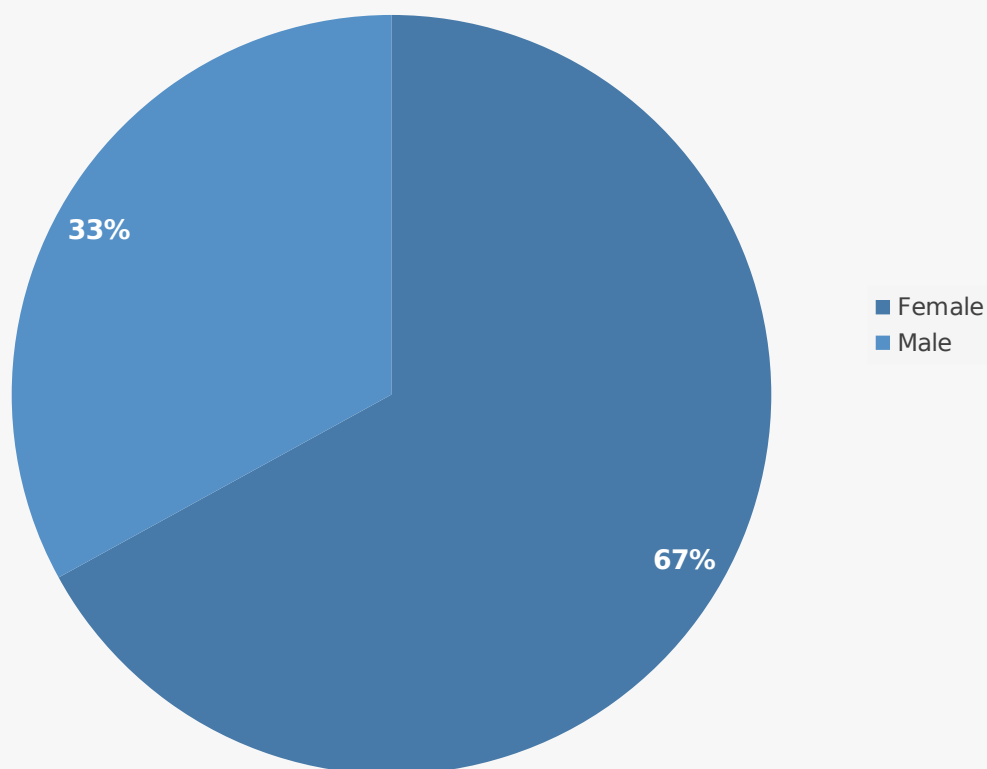

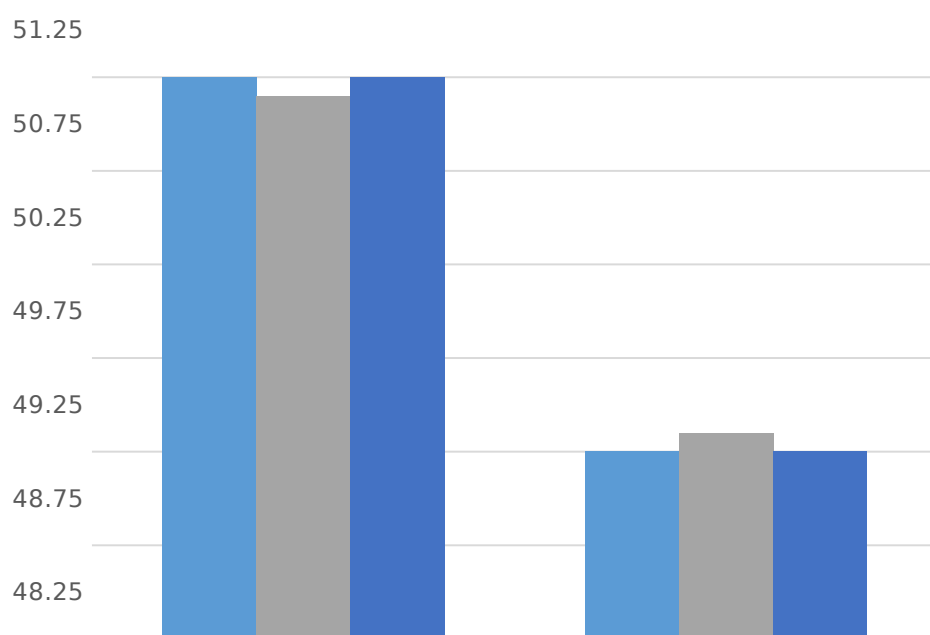
## What is your sex, as registered at birth?

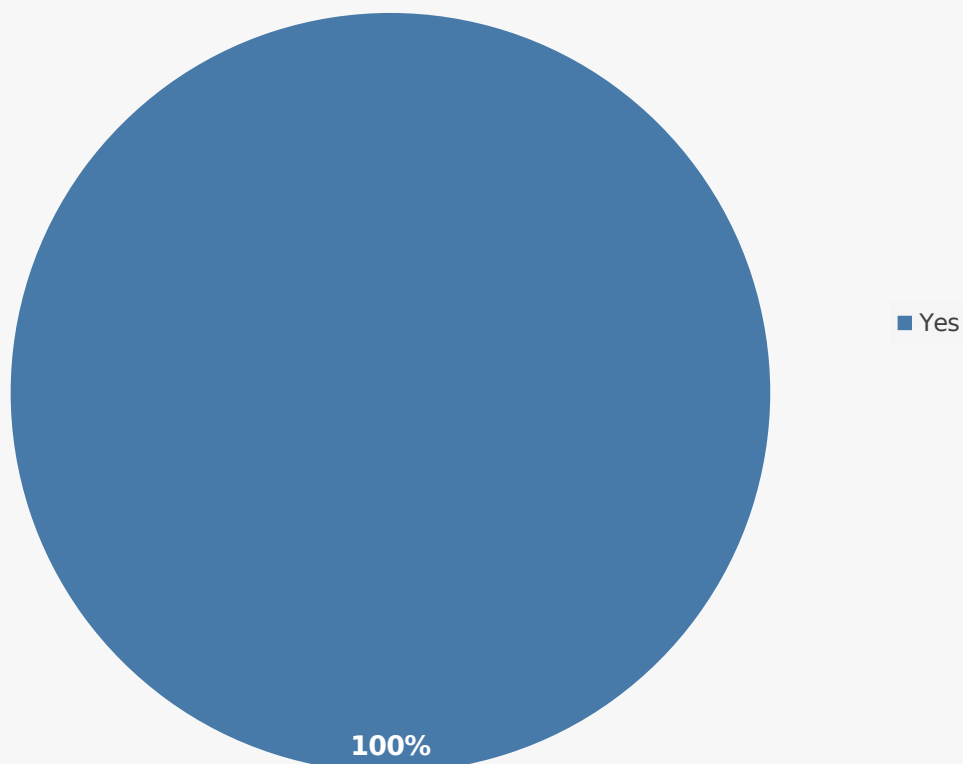

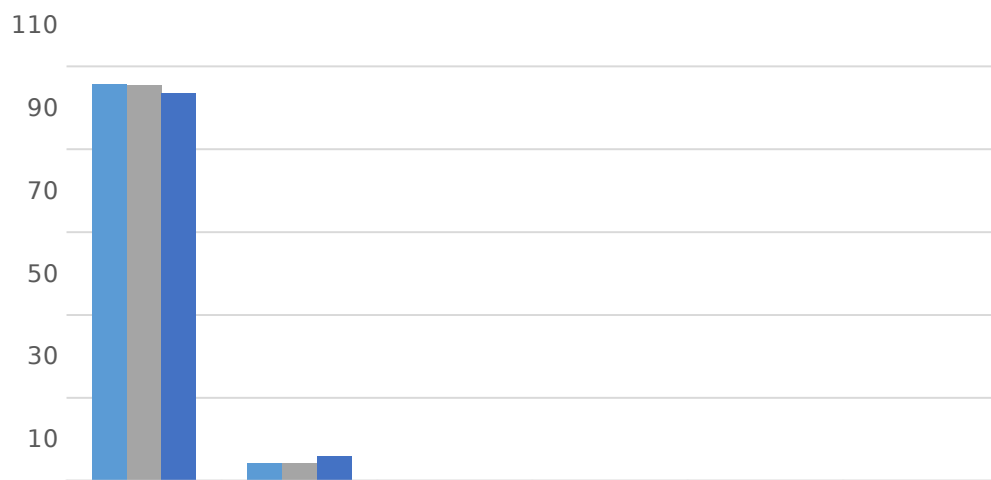

**Is the gender you identify with the same as your sex registered at birth?**



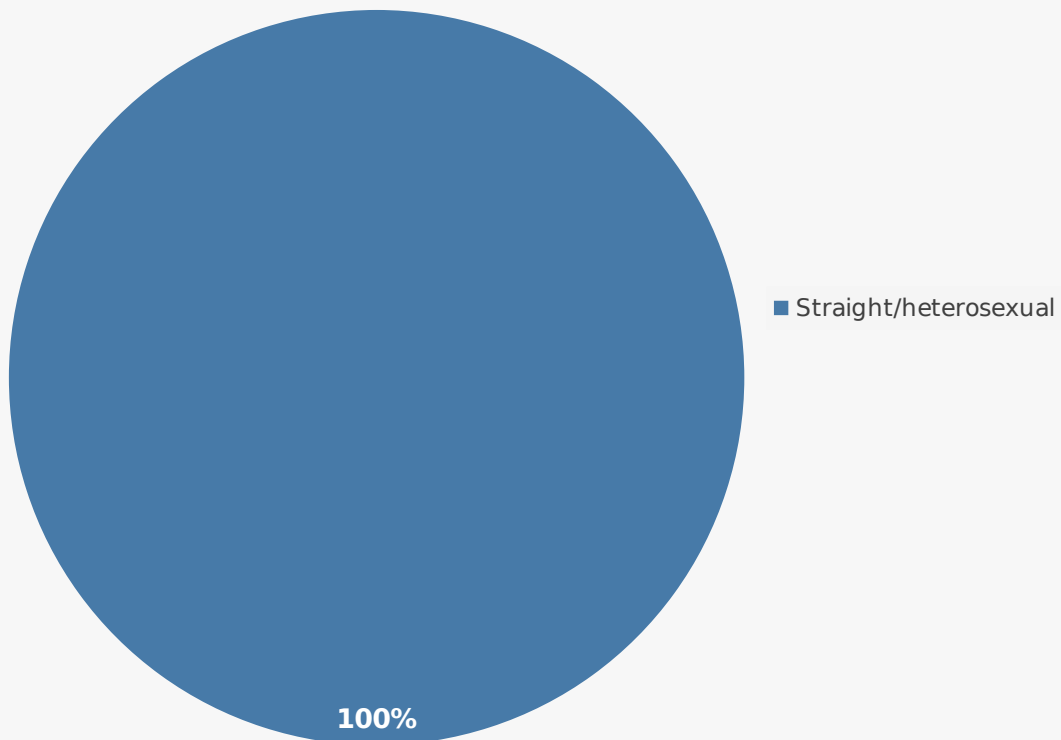

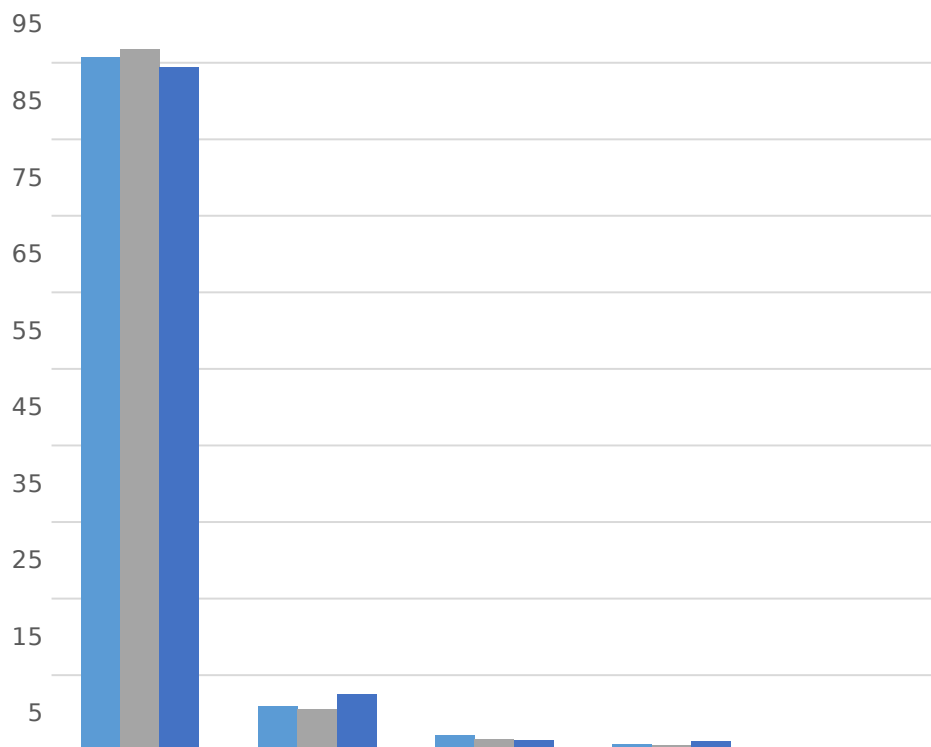
