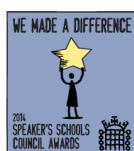

## Our plans for next half term.....

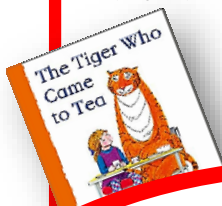
Monday 21 <sup>st</sup> February	A defibrillator to be fitted outside school (purchased with the kind donation from the John Wilding Clay Shoot).

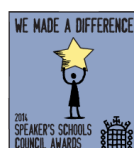
