### History:

This term our history topics are Stone Age to Bronze Age.

We will be finding out about the different stages of the stone age and thinking about how people lived in these times. We will be making our own tools, shelters and producing art work in the style of the Stone Age! We are also hoping to link our learning to a visit to Lancaster Museum with some hands on archaeology!

### RE:
