I am sure that you will all join with me in saying a big welcome back to Mrs. Darling, who I know, is really looking forward to seeing what you have all been up to since September.

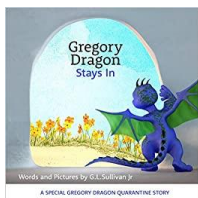
As many of you have remembered, we should have been having a two week break and not returning to school until Monday 8th June. However, we felt that under the circumstances you are probably better to be kept busy!
