Session 1	Celebration	Identify features of Christian celebrations.	Children will identify key features of a marriage and baptism. Session 2	Celebration		Children will have a vicar come into school to complete a mock baptism and marriage. Photographs will be used to evidence their learning. They will write a brief sentence to describe their experiences in the afternoon.		Children will know key features of these events and will be able to list important features of the celebrations.
Session 3	Celebration		Children will sort features into celebrations. This will recap previous knowledge of other Christian celebrations such as Easter and Christmas. Children will sort key features to match each.		Children will be able to identify traditions that take place at each event. Children will demonstrate their prior knowledge from previous RE days.
Session 4	Celebration		Children will list features found at a wedding and baptism. Children will complete a true or false exit ticket to gain an understanding of their knowledge and the gaps that need addressing.		Children will draw upon their learning of the day and write a list of features found at a wedding and baptism. This will have been covered throughout the day.
