### What should I already know?

I should be able to name some religious leaders in Christianity and Judaism. I should be able to explain why Moses and Joseph were important leaders and recall stories about them from the Bible.

### What do I need to know? – Key Knowledge

I should know/explore what makes a person inspirational.

I should know that there are many people all over the world who have influenced and inspired people. I should be able to name some of these people and say why they are influential.

I should be able to describe the lives of 2 inspirational people from Christianity, Islam or another faith. I should know any challenges that they faced and the role that their spirituality/faith played in their lives.

### What should I know more about? – In-Depth Study

- I should learn about the life of two inspirational people in today's world from 2 different faiths. Examples include Martin Luther King, Mother Teresa, the Dalai Lama, Malala Yousafzai or Gandhi.
- I should describe how these people lived their lives and influenced others.
- I should be able to describe the changes they faced and the commitments by which they lived.
- I should be able to apply my own ideas of how leaders can give wisdom and inspiration to those who follow them.

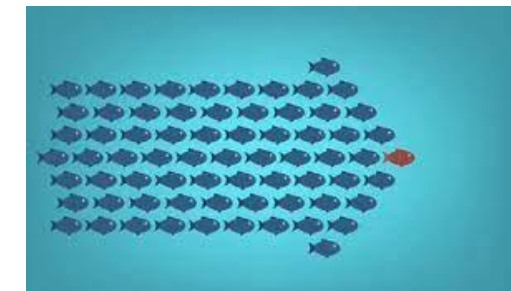
### Expected Standard
